Review of December 21, 2020 Regular Board Meeting

Mark Iiames, board president, called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., held in room 116 in the Lecture Hall at Miami East High School. The country was honored by the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll Call was taken with board members Kevin Accurso, John Demmitt, Brandon Fellers, Mark

Iiames, and Mike Rindler in attendance.

Also in attendance were: Matt Clevenger, Troy Daily News.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no public comments heard.

INFORMATIONAL REPORT:

Based on guidance from the **Centers of Disease Control and Prevention** (CDC), the Ohio Department of Health and Miami County Public Health **adopted recommendations to reduce the duration of quarantine** for those individuals *potentially* exposed to COVID-19.

Quarantine Durations

- Option 1 Stay at home for at least 14 days after last exposure. This is the Optimal Duration to Minimize Risk of Transmission. A 14-day quarantine period presents the lowest risk of post-quarantine transmission.
- **Option 2 Stay at home for at least 10 days** after last exposure. After ten days and not experiencing any symptoms. It is not necessary to have your son/daughter tested to return to school.
- Option 3 Stay at home for at least 7 days after last exposure. This requires a Negative PCR test result for SARS-CoV-2, not the rapid test (the virus that causes COVID-19) from a sample collected on day five or later after last exposure AND stay at home for at least seven days after last exposure. A copy of this negative test needs to be returned to the school.
