Review of June 15, 2020 Regular Board Meeting

Mark Iiames, board president, called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., held in room 116 in the Lecture Hall at Miami East High School. The country was honored by the Pledge of Allegiance. Roll Call was taken with board members Kevin Accurso, John Demmitt, Brandon Fellers, Mark Iiames, and Mike Rindler in attendance.

INFORMATIONAL REPORT

This year certainly took on a life of its own and was one nobody could have predicted. We were thrust into a new education world without notice but through the collaboration between schools and home we were able to work together to make the best of an unprecedented time.

We, as you, hope the start of the 2020-2021 school year begins as a normal school year. Currently, under the "safer at home" order, we have restrictions that limit our physical distancing to six feet and restrict our gatherings to be in groups of 10 or less. Between now and the fall, those restrictions could be altered, extended, tightened, or possibly lifted. I can assure you that we will do everything in our power to meet the needs of all of our students and families while keeping the health and safety of everyone as our highest priority.

Learning plans are currently being developed by Miami East to ensure we are able to deliver successful student outcomes throughout the next school year. As we plan for the many possibilities of the fall, we will continue to work with our partners in health and education—Miami County Health Department, Center for Disease Control, and Ohio Department of Education—to ensure we are following all necessary safety protocols.

We would love to be able to share a fall plan where students and teachers re-engaged in what we used to call normal school. It may not be until August that we are given the most updated guidelines for the start of the 2020-2021 school year. Please be patient. As plans become final, we will keep you informed.
