

PAC MEETING MINUTES

Wednesday, August 29, 2012

Mr. Allen Mack called the meeting of the Parent Advisory Committee to order. In attendance, were Allen Mack, Loretta Taylor, Linda Westgerdes, Casandra Carsey, and Colleen Woolley.

Secretary's Report – Mr. Mack briefly went over the last secretary's report. No additions or corrections were made.

Treasurer's Report – Mr. Mack reported as of July 31, 2012, the PAC account balance was \$4,454.77.

Election of Officers – Loretta Taylor agreed to move up to President after serving as Vice-President last year. Colleen Woolley – agreed to take the position of Treasurer. Due to the small group, it was decided to wait until the next meeting to elect a Secretary and Vice-President.

Old Business:

- ❖ Market Day – we agreed to collaborate with the Miami East Elementary PTO on this fundraiser with the PAC receiving 30% of the sales.
- ❖ School/PAC Fundraiser – Mr. Mack announced that the Jr. High would be having a fundraiser again this year much like last year's. The fundraiser will kick-off on September 13, 2012 with an assembly and run through October 1, 2012. The delivery date of the products has yet to be determined.

New Business:

- ❖ Blue & White Tickets –
