## **General Information**

Miami East High School was formed through a consolidation of township schools in 1957. A rich history of academic and athletic accomplishments has created great pride in the Miami East community and has provided an impetus for an active Alumni Association. With an interest in preserving traditional roots, the high school is also committed to preparing our students for the 21<sup>st</sup> century. The strategic planning process is being followed to fulfill the school's mission of providing a high quality education.

## **Community**

The Miami East Local School District is a rural area with small towns and suburban residences that covers 118 square miles. Miami East is located in northeastern Miami County and east of the cities of Piqua and Troy.

## **Boosters**

Miami East High School has three booster organizations that provide input and support. They are: Academic Boosters, Athletic Boosters, and Music Boosters. All three Booster organizations meet monthly.

Our staff's attendance was 96% and our student attendance was over 95%. This meets the state criteria for excellence.



## **Miami East High School**

Miami East High School is a comprehensive high school for grades 9-12. The enrollment in 2012-2013 was 392 students, with 41 students attending the Miami Valley Career Technology Center and/or Upper Valley Joint Vocational School. The Miami East High school operates on an eight period schedule and is on a semester plan. Credit is awarded at each semester. 28 juniors and seniors participated in Dual Enrollment college course work while still attending Miami East High School.

## **Miami East High School Graduation Requirements**

A minimum of twenty-two (22) credits is required for graduation from Miami East High School. Four credits in English, three in Mathematics, three in science, three in social studies credits, including American History and Government, one-half credit in Physical Education and Health must be completed before graduation. One credit of Fine Arts, Technology, or Foreign Language is also required.

## **Weighted Grade Point Average**

During the junior and senior year honors courses are offered in the areas of: English, Math, Science, Social Studies, and Foreign Language. These courses receive additional weight which raises the overall GPA of the student.

## **Extra Curricular Activities**

Miami East Local Schools has a full range of boys' and girls' athletic teams with a long tradition of outstanding performances, such as, the girls volleyball team capturing a state title two years in a row, the boys basketball team winning the State Basketball championship in 1996, and State Runner-Up in 2001, the girls basketball team made it to the State Tournament Final Four in 1997, and was State Runner-Up in 1998. The district also boasts many state qualifiers in track and wrestling. In 2005 we had our 1<sup>st</sup> State Champion in Wrestling. In 2012 the Varsity Football qualified for the state playoffs for the third time in the past seven years.

Miami East is a member of the Cross County Conference (CCC). In addition, students may participate in a variety of activities, such as performing arts, muse machine, national honor society, art

club, environmental club, student council, yearbook, Key Club, FFA, and academic team.
