#### The Grateful Whale

As reported by the San Francisco Chronicle

If you read the front page story of the San Francisco Chronicle on Thursday, Dec 15, 2005, you would have read about a female humpback whale that had become entangled in a spider web of crab traps and lines.



The fifty-foot whale was weighted down by hundreds of pounds of traps that caused her to struggle to stay afloat. She also had hundreds of yards of line rope wrapped around her tail, her torso and a line tugging in her mouth.

A fisherman spotted her just east of the Farallone Islands (outside the Golden Gate) and radioed an environmental group for help. Within a few hours, the rescue team arrived and determined that she was so bad off, the only way to save her was to dive in and untangle her - a very dangerous proposition. One slap of the tail could kill a rescuer.

They worked for hours with curved knives and eventually freed her. When she was free, the divers say she swam in what seemed like joyous circles. She then came back to each and every diver, one at a time, and nudged them, pushed them gently around - she thanked them. Some said it was the most incredibly beautiful experience of their lives.

The guy who cut the rope out of her mouth says her eye was following him the whole time, and he will never be the same.

May you, and all those you love, be so blessed and fortunate -to be surrounded by people who will help you get untangled from the things that are binding you.

And, may you always know the joy of giving and receiving gratitude.







## **KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION AND SCREENING May 4th & May 5th**

It is with pleasure that we welcome your child to Kindergarten at Miami East Local Schools for the 2023-2024 academic year! We look forward to an educational and enriching Kindergarten year for your child at Miami East Elementary.

Your child is eligible to begin Kindergarten at Miami East Elementary in the 2023-2024 school year if your child will be five years old on or before August 1, 2023 and meets the residency requirements.

### **REGISTRATION PERIOD: February 1st – May 3rd**

Registration is started by visiting <https://miamieast-oh.finalforms.com/> Once an account has been created for the incoming student and required forms have been completed online families should email Mrs. Mumford at [mmumford@miamieast.k12.oh.us](mailto:mmumford@miamieast.k12.oh.us) She will check online documents and schedule an appointment for the Academic Screening.

#### **When you log-in to FinalForms:**

1. Only Register your incoming **Kindergarten** student. If you have other siblings at Miami East, wait until later in the summer to register those students.
2. Select "I'm a New Enrollment"
3. Register for the 2023-2024 school year, not the current school year.

The registration process must be started by May 3rd, for your child to participate in the May 4th & May 5th Academic Screening.

### **ACADEMIC SCREENING: May 4th & May 5<sup>th</sup> ( 8:00 a.m.- 2:00 p.m.)**

Upon arriving at the Elementary, please check in at the Kindergarten Doors with Mrs. Mumford to turn in required documents. We ask that families arrive with one adult only and the student to be screened.
