- \Rightarrow Remove any screen or filter from your faucet.
- ⇒ Run water for five minutes to clear the lines and bring in fresh water.
- ⇒ Do not touch the lip of the jar, inside the jar, or inside of the cap.
- ⇒ Fill the bottle and cap it snugly.
- \Rightarrow Keep the sample refrigerated until the Test Your Well Fair.
