The 95th National FFA Convention is the largest event hosted by the National FFA. 20 members of the Miami East-MVCTC FFA chapter were in attendance at the convention in Indianapolis, Indiana. Over 65,000 members, parents, and guests were in attendance at the National FFA Convention. Previous conventions were held in Kansas City, Missouri and Louisville, Kentucky.

Convention activities included attending several convention sessions where members were inspired by motivational speakers such as the 2021-2022 National FFA Officers and four-time Olympic gold medalist and WNBA player Tamika Catchings. Attendees enjoyed attending the Lauren Alaina and Jimmie Allen concert, World's Toughest Rodeo, the FFA Shopping Mall and Career Show, and a tour of the Ozark Fishery and Crossroad Genetics Boar Stud.

The Miami East-MVCTC FFA Chapter received a Three-Star National Chapter Award, the highest award bestowed to an FFA Chapter. The chapter was selected for this honor based on its activities during the previous school year, in the areas of growing leaders, building communities, and strengthening agriculture.

Becky is a Licensed School Counselor and Licensed Practicing Clinical Counselor.

Hope Squad

Miami East High School has fully implemented Hope Squad for the 2021-2022 school year. Hope Squad is a peer-to-peer suicide prevention and mental health awareness program. Students that serve as Hope Squad members are nominated by their classmates as trustworthy peers. In addition to the student Hope Squad members, there are seven high school staff members that are trained Hope Squad advisors. The MEHS Hope Squad members and their advisors will promote resilience and self-care among the students at Miami East High School. Hope Squad members reduce the stigma associated with mental illness and mental health and show that it's okay to seek help.

School Safety Drill – November 22nd

Schools are still some of the safest places for children, in part, due to the practice drills we conduct on a routine basis. These drills include Fire Drills, Tornado Drills, and Lockdown Drills. (Lockdowns are drills designed to prepare a building for either an inside or an outside threat.)

Drills are not meant to scare but to prepare!

Staff members and students train and practice new approaches to lockdown drills. Our students will again be given information and then participate in our **first safety drill** this school year on **Tuesday, November 22nd**.

In emergency events.... every situation is unique.

In general, our actions will depend on the location of the intruder. Staff members and students will be trained to consider the following options:

1. **BARRICADE.** Depending on the location of the intruder, staff and students will be trained to barricade themselves in locked classrooms and stack chairs, tables, and desks against the door as high as possible.
2. **EVACUATE.** If the intruder is in another part of the building, or the students are in a hallway or an open area, the safest option may be to evacuate the building. In these circumstances the teacher and students will escape outside.
