The Veteran's Day Breakfast was a very big hit!

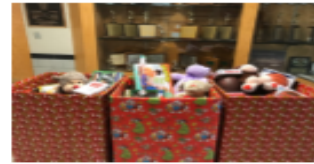
Miami East High School hosted a Veterans Day Breakfast on Nov. 11th for all Veterans and Active Military. Thanks to all who attended!

Junior High Viking Learning Center (VLC)

About the Center

The Viking Learning Center is open on Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays after school to all junior high students until 4pm in room 602/computer lab. All are encouraged to take advantage of this excellent opportunity as a way of receiving extra academic support, receiving tutoring help to complete homework, or missing/absent assignments. The goal of the VLC is to produce a relaxed yet productive work space for our MEJH students. Students are not required to stay the whole time in the learning center, parents may coordinate pick up at any time before 4pm from the main entrance of the junior high.

In order to create the proper learning environment, we ask that all students respect the following VLC expectations:

- All students must sign in/out of the VLC each day.
- Students must ask and receive permission from a VLC supervisor before leaving the VLC to use the restroom, visit a locker, or look for a teacher.
- Students must respect the designated quiet study space in the lab.
- As the technology policy states, computers are for educational purposes.
- Snacks are ok to bring, but students are responsible for cleaning up any trash left behind.
- Cell phones are allowed to be used as long as they are not a distraction to others and only for the purpose of coordinating rides with their parents/guardians.
- Please refrain from any other actions that can be considered a distraction to other students in the VLC.

- Check with your employer (if you work), your coach (if you play a sport), church, organizations for scholarship opportunities.

Alumni Hall of Fame

The Alumni Hall of Fame applications are currently available in the Board office. Each year nominations for the Miami East Alumni Hall of Fame are sought from employees of the district, alumni, and community members. Application should be sent to the Superintendent's office. Committee members who are selected by the superintendent will then meet and review the nominated candidates in March. The deadline for nominations is January 30, 2023.

The following criteria are used for selection of alumni candidates for Induction:

- A. Outstanding achievement in vocational pursuits
- B. Outstanding contributions in community and/or government affairs.
- C. Meritorious recognition for some action taken or provided.
- D. Significant philanthropic involvement.

School Safety Drill – November 22nd

Schools are still some of the safest places for children, in part, due to the practice drills we conduct on a routine basis. These drills include Fire Drills, Tornado Drills, and Lockdown Drills. (Lockdowns are drills designed to prepare a building for either an inside or an outside threat.)

Drills are not meant to scare but to prepare!

Staff members and students train and practice new approaches to lockdown drills. Our students will again be given information and then participate in our **first safety drill** this school year on **Tuesday, November 22nd**.

In emergency events.... every situation is unique.

In general, our actions will depend on the location of the intruder. Staff members and students will be trained to consider the following options:

1. **BARRICADE.** Depending on the location of the intruder, staff and students will be trained to barricade themselves in locked classrooms and stack chairs, tables, and desks against the door as high as possible.
2. **EVACUATE.** If the intruder is in another part of the building, or the students are in a hallway or an open area, the safest option may be to evacuate the building. In these circumstances the teacher and students will escape outside.
