Third Grade Guarantee

Just a reminder, this year will be the third year of the Third Grade Guarantee. The ability to read is the foundation of learning. Research shows that children who are not reading at a third grade level by the end of grade three will likely have trouble learning in all classroom subjects in higher grades. As a result, the Ohio General Assembly approved Senate Bill 21.

Third Grade students must meet a minimum score on the state reading test to move on to the fourth grade. This score must be attained either in the Fall or Spring administration of the state reading test.

Whereas, the District is a participating member of the Ohio High School Athletic Association (OHSAA); and Whereas, the District therefore has agreed to the rules and regulations promulgated by OHSAA; It is therefore resolved as follows:

- 1. The operation of unmanned aerial vehicles (UAVs), commonly known as drones, is prohibited on the Miami East Local School District premises during District-sponsored contests (including scrimmages and previews), practices, and activities under the auspices of the Ohio High School Athletic Association (OHSAA).
- 2. District officials may deny admission or entry to anyone attempting to use a UAV until the event has been completed.
- 3. Any exceptions to this regulation must be approved in advance by the Superintendent.
