

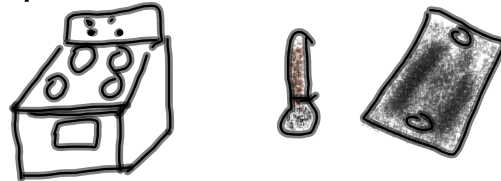
## Producing Mr. Roth's Pencil Holders

Natural resources I used included clay to mold my pencil holders out of and water to moisten my clay. I used paint also and some of the dyes in paint come from flowers.

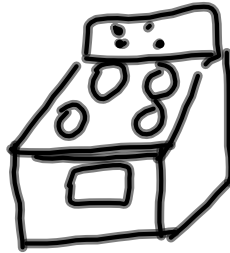
### Capital Goods
