

Miami East P.A.C. Minutes  
Wednesday, November 3, 2010  
Meeting Minutes

**INTRODUCTIONS:** Those in attendance: Jeannie Marlow, MaryAnn Bick, Stephanie Copeland, Allen Mack, Lisa Magoto, Marsha DeWeese, Michelle Coates, and Linda Westgerdes.

**REPORTS:**

- A. Secretary's Report – The following items were noted for correction:  
\$1,470.50 under Treasurer's Report was the first amount deposited for the Great American Fundraiser. Total checks written totaled \$200. The return check fee will be \$19. Steph Copeland made the motion to accept the Secretary's report with the above corrections. Michelle Coates seconded the motion. Motion Carried.
- B. Treasurer's Report – Given by Michelle Coates. As of today, the balance is \$15,666.73. Total withdrawals since October 1, 2010 were \$1,318.88 and total deposits \$14,260.50. Majority of the deposits were from the Great American Fundraiser. Mr. Mack mentioned that our profit from the Great American Fundraiser will average about 40% of total sales. Lisa Magoto made the first motion to approve the Treasurer's Report and Steph Copeland seconded it. Motion Carried.
- C. Old Business –
1. Student Directories – A copy of the directories were distributed to those in attendance. Everyone seemed very pleased with the finished product.
  2. Operation Grade Card/Staff Meals – November 4th & 8th from 3:00 to 6:30 p.m. Meals have been planned and everything seems to be in order.
  3. Student Rewards/Incentives – Mr. Mack announced that the first White Ticket drawing was held today. The movie tickets seemed to go over great as well as the Miami East Spirit Wear. Mr. Mack mentioned that our inventory of Miami East Spirit wear is low. Steph Copeland agreed to contact Indian Creek Sportswear and get some additional ME items. Those in attendance agreed for Steph to spend around \$200 on T-Shirts, Shoe Bags, Spirit Towels, temporary tattoos, bracelets, and socks. Steph also said she would contact Movies 5 about getting more movie tickets at a discounted price. Michelle Coates is going to contact Family Video in Piqua and Lisa Magoto agreed to go to Diary Queen in Piqua and get some gift cards/donations.
  4. Parent Volunteers for Fundraiser Delivery – Fundraiser items will be delivered and dispersed to the students/parents during Operation Grade Card November 4th & 8<sup>th</sup> between 3 & 5:00 p.m. Volunteers are in place for all phases of this.

D. New Business –

1. Cotillion Dates – no date was selected. It was decided to wait till next month's meeting. The idea of including 6<sup>th</sup> graders this year was brought up but was dismissed.

E. Other Discussion Items -

1. Limo Ride for those students selling 20 or more items during the recent Great American Fundraiser will be November 29, 2010. These students will be going to BW3's for lunch. The PAC will be covering the cost of the limo and the sale rep for Great American will be covering the cost of lunch. Mr. Mack mentioned that this year's fund raiser has had the highest sales ever.
2. Rachel's Challenge meetings were held last month and seemed to be well received by all from High School Seniors to Senior Citizens down to the elementary students attending the evening program with their parents.
3. Janet Stevens asked Mr. Mack if the PAC would help fund the paper, printing and lamination cost of recognizing students who made the honor roll or principals' list this past quarter. Steph Copeland made the motion to approve these expenses. Those in attendance agreed.
