Review of June 13, 2011 Special Board Meeting

Rusty Miller, board president, called the Special Board meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., held in room 602 at Miami East Junior High School. The country was honored by the Pledge of Allegiance.

CONSTRUCTION REPORT

Jim Price from The Buehrer Group was in attendance to to update the Board of Education on the enclosure bids that were received. Mr. Price explained that the enclosure bids came in under the estimated bid estimate. In addition, the district is converting the fuel oil boilers to propane. The district expects to save the total cost with this portion of the project in the first year. Additionally, the district will explore the possibility of converting the current fuel oil tank to a diesel tank to be able to purchase larger shipments of diesel at lower costs.
