# MIAMI EAST LOCAL SCHOOLS BOARD BITS

Review of October 18, 2010 Regular Board Meeting

Rusty Miller, board president, called the regular meeting to order at 7:00 p.m., held in room 602 at Miami East Junior High School. The country was honored by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call was taken with board members Kevin Accurso, Brad Burton, Gayle Carson, Mark Davis, and Rusty Miller in attendance.

Also in attendance were: LaDonna Mays, staff member; Allen Mack, junior high principal; Jerry Black, staff member; Kent Buehrer, The Buehrer Group; Sherri Sherock, The Buehrer Group; Kim Plummer, The Quandel Group; Dennis Schumaker, The Quandel Group; Justin Koenes, The Quandel Group; and Melanie Yingst, Troy Daily Newspaper.

### **PUBLIC COMMENTS**

There were no public comments heard.

#### GOOD NEWS RECOGNITION:

The Buehrer Group and the Quandel Group updated the Board of Education on the status of the construction of the new high school.

Sherri Sherrock from the Buehrer Group presented the initial color selections of the new high school. Sherri described the terrazzo flooring pattern in the corridors that would include a blue and white pattern. Additionally, the hallways would include a wainscot pattern between the lockers. The wainscot would serve both as an aesthetically pleasing feature and functionality much easier to maintain.

The classrooms would include oak colored cabinets, vinyl flooring, and a colored accent wall where the smartboard would be located. Mrs. Sherrock delivered a color board to the high school for the staff, students, and community members to view.

Kim Plummer and Dennis Schumaker from The Quandel Group updated the Board on the progress of construction. Mr. Schumaker reported that the split face block and exterior brick work was nearly 80% complete. Additionally, as of this week the following items have been completed or are next on the schedule:

- ❖ Continue placing the roof panels on the classrooms in front of the building.
- ❖ Masonry work in the locker rooms areas.
- **!** Exterior brick work on the back of the high school.
- Continue the blocking for the roofing and setting door frames
- ❖ Installed the under drains in the Court Yard and started grading for the sidewalks
- Continued the interior non load bearing walls
- ❖ Continued installing the brick on the exterior the Ag Shops, Kitchen and Courtyard.
- Installed roof decking
- Completed framing for the Gym windows and soffit
- Started the roof installation on the Gym
